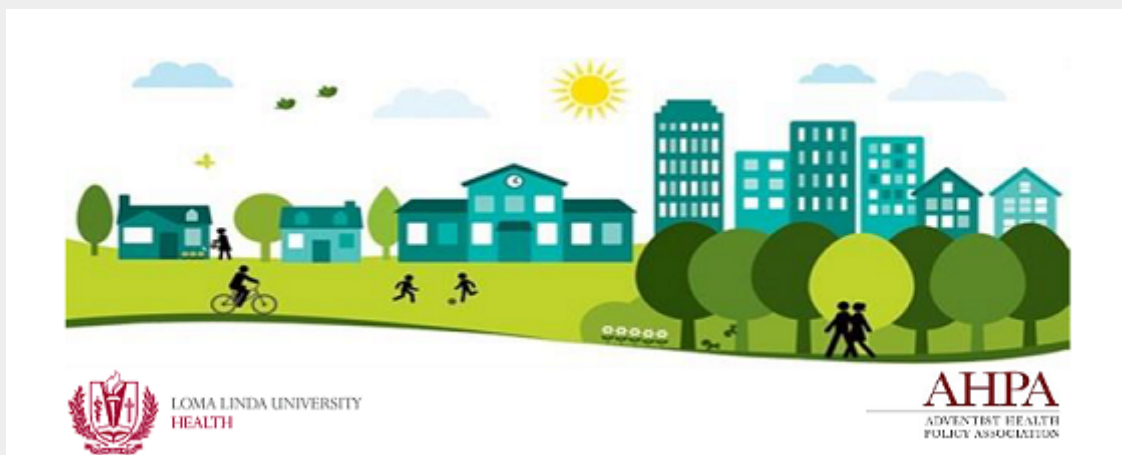
### **ACA Repeal and Replace Debate**

Last week both the House and the Senate passed a budget resolution that starts the process of repealing the Affordable Care Act. The resolution is a fiscal “blueprint” that instructs relevant committees on how to begin working on the bill that repeals the Affordable Care Act. The committees

have until January 27, 2017 to complete the legislation. At this point it is very hard to say what any repeal legislation will actually include and if there will indeed be a concurrent replacement plan offered by Republican leaders of Congress. President-elect Trump indicated he favors passing a repeal and replacement plan as close to concurrently as possible.

AHPA will be watching this closely and will send updates on what exactly will be repealed and what a replacement will look like.
